A LAW TO AMEND THE EMPLOYERS' LIABILITY
(COMPULSORY INSURANCE)
LAWS OF 1989 to 1997

The House of Representatives enacts as follows:

	Short title.
<p>1. This law may be cited as the Employers' Liability (Compulsory Insurance) (Amendment) Law of 2001 and shall be read as one with the Employers' Liability (Compulsory Insurance) Laws of 1989 to 1997 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal law") and the principal law and this law may together be cited as the Employers' Liability (Compulsory Insurance) Laws of 1989 to 2001.</p>	<p>174 of 1989 63(1) of 1997</p>

Section 5 of the basic law is hereby amended by the substitution of the proviso to subsection (1) thereof with the following new proviso in paragraph (b) :</p> <p>« Provided that the policy shall not be required to cover -</p> <p>(i) Any liability of the employer arising out of an agreement which would not have arisen, if such an agreement did not exist; and</p> <p>(ii) any liability in relation to the death or bodily injury of any employee carried in a motor vehicle and arising out of or in the course of his employment. ».</p>	<p>Amendment of section 5 of the principal law.</p>
