

A LAW TO AMEND THE EMPLOYERS' LIABILITY (COMPULSORY INSURANCE) LAW

The House of Representatives enacts as follows:

<p>Short Title. 174 of 1989 63 (l) of 1997 15 (l) of 2001 140 (l) of 2003</p>	<p>1. This law may be cited as the Employers' Liability (Compulsory Insurance) (Amendment) Law of 2010 and shall be read as one with the Employers' Liability (Compulsory Insurance) Laws of 1989 to 2003 (hereinafter referred to as «the principal law») and the principal law and this law may together be cited as the Employers' Liability (Compulsory Insurance) Laws of 1989 to 2010.</p>
<p>Amendment of section 9 of the principal law.</p>	<p>2. Section 9 of the principal law is amended as follows :</p> <p>(a) By the substitution of the words «seven (7) days» (first line) in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) with the words «fourteen (14) days» and the substitution of the semicolon at the end thereof with a colon and by the addition, immediately thereafter, of the following new proviso:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">«Provided that the condition of this paragraph does not apply where the details of the insurer are unknown;»; and</p> <p>(b) by the substitution in the proviso of subsection (3) of the words «seven (7) days» (third line) with the words «fourteen (14) days».</p>
<p>Amendment of section 19 of the principal law.</p>	<p>3. Section 19 of the principal law is amended by the substitution of the words «two (2) years» with the words «three (3) years» wherever it occurs.</p>
