Your Excellency,

I refer to previous discussions in PSC and COTER and the guidance of the 19 June 2017 Foreign Affairs Council Conclusion to maintain and expand the network of counterterrorism/security experts to EU Delegations.

In this context, I am pleased to inform you that we are seeking applications from Member States for a "<u>co-financed</u>" national expert (SNE) for secondment to the Delegation of the European Union to Nigeria and the ECOWAS, pursuant to the Decision of the High Representative of 04.02.2014 establishing the rules applicable to SNEs<sup>1</sup>.

The SNE would be posted at the EU Delegation in Abuja (Nigeria).

The CT/Security Experts will work under the direct supervision of the Head of Delegation to Nigeria, reporting to the Head of Division, EEAS.SECDEFPOL.3, working directly with relevant colleagues both from the Delegation and Headquarters. Following the EEAS practice and legal framework, CT/Security Experts are considered as staff members of the EEAS. Reporting/analysis, building a security network and local EU coordination in the area of security, counterterrorism and transnational crime will remain their main tasks.

The secondment is foreseen for a period of 2 years (renewable).

I would be obliged if you could forward the enclosed profile to the various relevant Ministries in order to generate adequate applications. Ideally, we are looking at candidates with a Law Enforcement background (police, intelligence, defence) as well as experience in Security Sector Reform, Counterterrorism/Serious and Major transnational crimes related issues. Field experience in conflict/post-conflict countries is mandatory. Local language and previous experience in the region are comparative advantages.

Candidates shall draft their CVs in English or in French in a PDF or Word version, following the European CV form which can be found at the following internet address: <u>http://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/en/documents/curriculum-vitae</u>.

Only applications received in the above-mentioned format by **22 January 2021 noon** (**Brussels time**) will be taken into consideration. Applications will be examined by the EEAS which will, in principle, organise interviews during February 2021.

Please note, that the delivery of a security clearance (minimum level <u>EU SECRET/SECRET</u> <u>UE</u>) is a prerequisite for all postings as an SNE to the EEAS and that a **HEAT training** (Hostile Environment Awareness Training) is <u>strongly recommended for this post, before</u> <u>taking up duties at the Delegation</u>.

I would like to invite you to draw the attention of the various relevant Ministries and services to the proper treatment of personal data and inform them that the EEAS implements data protection rules according to Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and of the Council.

Consequently, possible applicants should be informed that their CVs will be circulated to EEAS services involved in the selection and management of their possible secondment as well as within the Delegation concerned.

I take this opportunity to thank you very much for your cooperation and I look forward to a rapid deployment of this expert as an important contribution to EU efforts in the fight against terrorism and radicalisation.
