Your Excellency,

I am pleased to inform you of a vacancy within the European Economic and Social Committee for a seconded national expert in Directorate B – Legislative work, Unit B1 – External relations (REX). The tasks to be performed by the expert are detailed in the enclosed vacancy notice. The secondment to the EESC will be governed by Decision No 263/12A which came into force on 1 January 2012.

Our internal administrative procedure requires a pre-selection phase, organised by a panel of EESC representatives. Ideally, a total of five potential candidates are to be considered for the vacant position. Candidates available for an exploratory interview are encouraged to send their applications to their Permanent Representation, stating the reference number CESE/END/B1-REX/01/2022 of the vacancy notice. It is then up to the Permanent Representation to forward to the EESC any applications that it judges suitable and wishes to support.

To this end, I would be most grateful if you could forward the enclosed vacancy notice to the national authorities of the Member State you represent (English and French versions provided). The closing date for the receipt of applications by the EESC is noon on 1 September 2022. Applications received after that deadline will not be taken into consideration.

Applications and CVs from your pre-selected candidates should be sent preferably by email to the address of our functional mailbox expnat@eesc.europa.eu, created solely for this purpose.

The secondment of the retained candidate will be requested on conclusion of the selection interview, via the usual channel.
